- 3. Amount** *200 pieces, please count them carefully.*
- 4. Identification** *Identify yourself and the materials used to create your keepsake directly on the piece or on a label securely attached. Your name (and business name if applicable,) will be included in the Keepsake Table of Contents.*
- 5. Delivery** *Conference attendees must bring their contributions with them to Atlanta. Others should mail their pieces to the museum to arrive no later than October 1, 2008.*
