About Friends of Dard Hunter Scholarships

Each year, at our annual conference, funds are raised for scholarships through cash donations and the silent and live auctions. These funds are then applied to the scholarships the following year. These scholarships allow students and others of modest means to participate in our meetings. If you would not otherwise be able to afford this year's meeting, perhaps a scholarship would help to make it possible.

There are three levels of FDH scholarships available:

Regional:

\$175, for members who live within the annual meeting area. For this meeting it will include the states of Georgia, Tennessee, North Carolina, South Carolina and Alabama.

Full:

\$250, for members who live outside the annual meeting designated area. This includes all the other 45 states in the US.

The Elaine Koretsky International Scholarship:

\$400, for members who are traveling from outside the United States.

You must 18 years of age and a current member of the Friends to apply for a scholarship. As a scholarship candidate, your completed Annual Meeting Registration Form must be mailed before September 15th. Do not send any money with the Registration Form. Payment arrangements will be made after selection notification.

Please Note: you are ineligible for consideration if you have already received a FDH scholarship within the last three years. You may apply again after the three year waiting period.

Selection is based on the amount of funds available. If, in any given year, the number of applicants exceeds the amount of funds available, a random drawing of applicant names will take place by the FDH Executive Committee. All applicants will be notified in a timely manner after the September 15th deadline to allow for the completion of their travel plans.

Registration/Scholarship Form

The conference registration fee includes: keynote lecture and reception, Member's Exhibition Reception, Trade Fair, coffee and snacks on Friday and Saturday, auctions, keepsake, and main conference activities.

It does not include: airport transportation, lodging, pre-conference tours, parking, or the Regional Banquet.
